There are two important Rotary District 6780 events coming up in August. The first event is the annual Pack the Park to End Polio Now with the Tennessee Smokies on Tuesday, August 6th. This will be the last Pack the Park to End Polio Now at the Smokies Stadium in Kodak as the new stadium being built in Knoxville will open for the 2025 season. The Smokies will be playing the Chattanooga Lookouts with the game starting at 7:00 PM. Tickets are \$15/person, with \$6.50 from each ticket sold going to The Rotary Foundation PolioPlus Fund. Each ticket will also include a \$6.00 stadium credit voucher to be used at concessions or stadium vendors.
