David Stanley shared that the same judge the presides over the Men's Drug Court in Morgan County also presides over the Women's Drug Court Rehabilitation Center in Nashville. The following is from David:

They would love to have items donated for women such as clothes, helpful books, women's items, games and other things that our Rotary ladies know would be appreciated while in a year of drug rehabilitation and preparation for drug free life after discharge. Those who choose drug rehab rather than prison for non-violent crimes are discharged drug free and prepared for jobs and living in new locations where they will not be so easily tempted to take or sell illegal drugs. We can deliver these items to the Morgan County facility near Petros and the State Judge in charge of the 2 facilities will deliver the items to Nashville when he makes his monthly visit to Wartburg. If anyone would like to go with me and see the facility when I make our donations, you are welcome! Hope to have some women's items soon. Thank you all for your generous donations. You may also deduct the worth of your items on your taxes if you wish. Another good Rotary project for 2023-24!

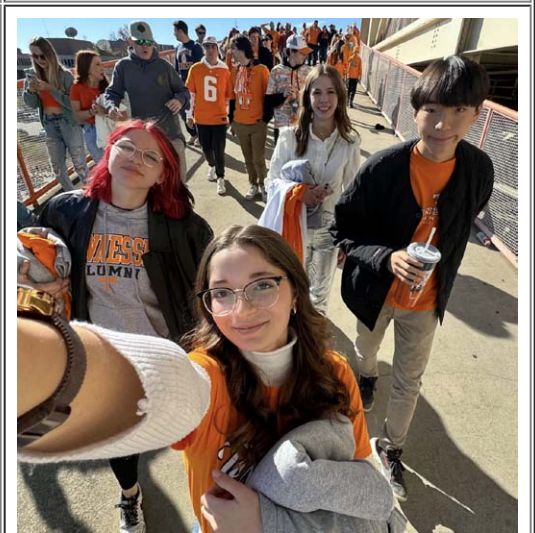
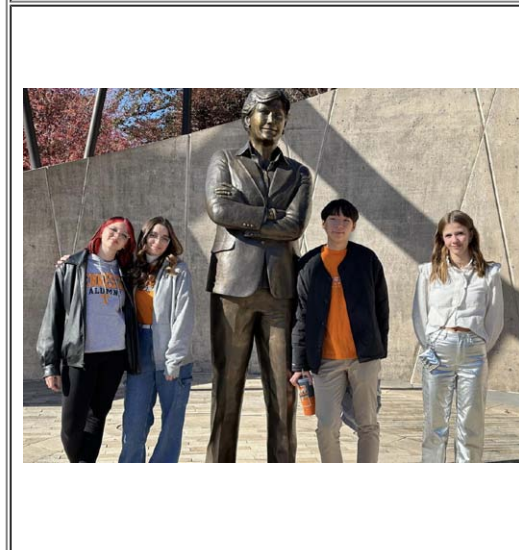
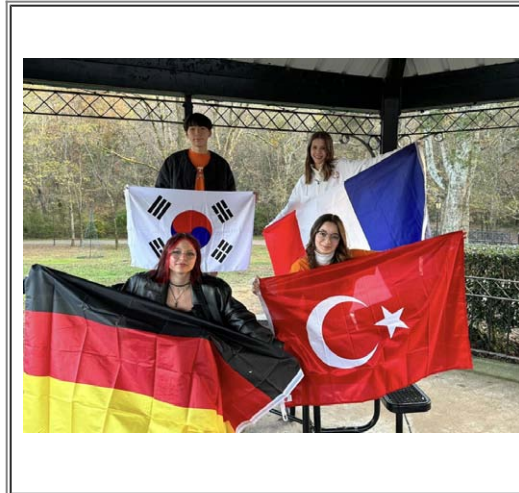
