### Please welcome District Governor Carol Argo

Carol was born in Montgomery, Alabama and graduated from Autauga County High School. She received a B.A. in history from Auburn University at Montgomery, M.A. in anthropology from the University of Alabama and a Masters of Science in Public Health from UAB. While a student at UAB, Carol began her career working with the School of Public Health in student affairs and admissions. In 1987 she became Foreign Student advisor for UAB and served as Director of International Scholar and Student Services until her retirement in June 2011.

Carol was introduced to Rotary through the Group Study Exchange program when she was selected as a member of a GSE team to England in 1995. In 1997 she joined the Rotary Club of Shades Valley and served as club international service director and club secretary before becoming club president in 2003-2004. She is a multiple Paul Harris Fellow, Paul Harris Society Member and Benefactor of the Rotary Foundation. At the district level she served on the Group /study Exchange subcommittee for ten years, chaired the Alumni subcommittee for one year, and served as AG for two years. She chaired the district grants subcommittee for two years prior to serving as district grants subcommittee chair during the Future Vision Pilot Program and through the first year of the new Rotary grants program.

Carol has been a Presidents-Elect Training (PETS) facilitator and is currently a member of the RLI and Visioning faculty. In May 2015 Carol was awarded the Thomas L. Milford Jr. Service Above Self Award by Rotary District 6860. She served as Governor of District 6860 in 2018-19 and is currently completing a second term as governor for 2022-2023. Carol resides in Mentone, Alabama and continues her membership in the Rotary Club of Shades Valley in Birmingham
