It is with heavy hearts and deep sadness that we announce the passing of Dr. Lee N. Allen. Lee was one of the charter members of the Rotary Club of Shades Valley, which was founded on October 31, 1963. He served as the seventh President of Shades Valley during the Rotary year 1969-1970. In 2020, Lee was honored by being named an Honorary Member of the club, a status he held until his death.

Dr. Allen was a beloved retired professor at Samford University and contributed his exceptional documentation skills to recording the history of not only the Shades Valley club but also Rotary International and District 6860.

Lee will be greatly missed by all who had the privilege to know him and share in the experiences of life and Rotary.

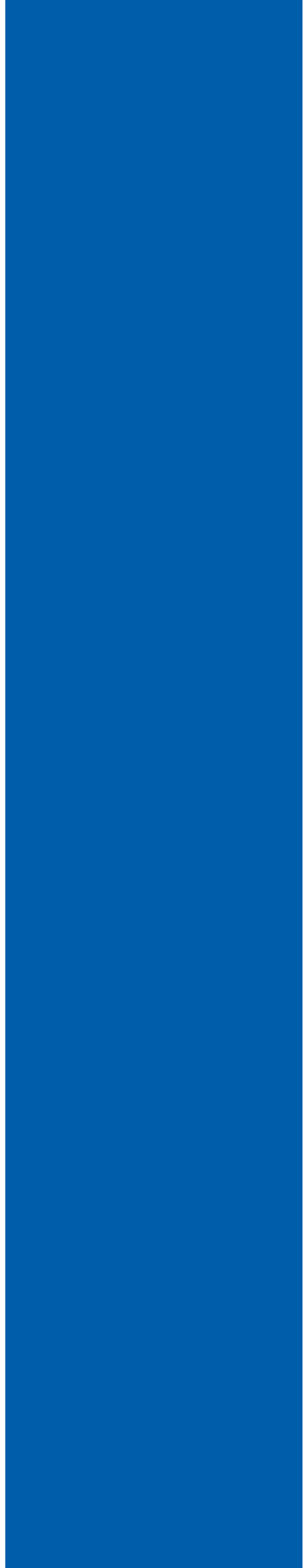
