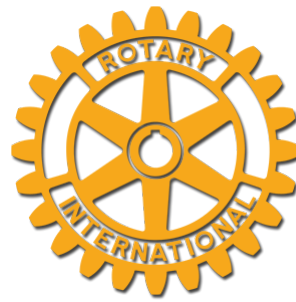

## Andy Kennedy - Head Basketball Coach at UAB

### Andy Kennedy



Andy Kennedy was named the seventh head coach of the UAB men's basketball program, Director of Athletics Mark Ingram announced on March 20, 2020.

Kennedy, who enters his third year with the program in 2022-23, returned to his alma mater where he is the second leading scorer in program history. A two-time SEC Coach of the Year and winningest coach in the University of Mississippi history, Kennedy coached at Ole Miss from 2006-2018, before spending two years as a commentator for ESPN and the SEC Network.

On July 21, 2022, Kennedy signed a six-year contract extension which goes through the 2027-28 season.

## Nominating Committee Selections

In accordance with our by-laws, the officers and directors who will lead our club for the Rotary year 2023-2024 will be elected during our Annual meeting which is scheduled for December 5, 2022.

A slate of candidates will be presented by a nominating committee at the Monday, November 14 meeting and at that same time the floor will be opened for additional nominations. All resulting nominated candidates will then be included on the ballot for election at the Annual meeting. Normally, the members of the nominating committee are selected at the first meeting in October each year, however, we have delayed that activity this year until Monday, Oct. 24. The Nominating Committee shall consist of the following persons: (i) the Immediate Past President of the Club, (ii) the Current President of the Club, (iii) the Current President-Elect of the Club, and (iv) five (5) members of the Club (the "At-Large Members") selected by the members of the Club in the manner described below:

Each club member shall list three (3) eligible club members whom he or she would recommend to serve on the Nominating Committee. In order to know who is eligible, an announcement shall be made from the podium explaining that all current board members (with the exception of any Past President of the Club serving as an at-large board member) and those members (by name) who have served on the past three (3) consecutive Nominating Committees are ineligible for consideration. Additionally, any member who has advised of his or her preference not to serve on the Nominating Committee also shall be announced.

Members in attendance in-person on Oct. 24 will have their completed suggestion slips collected by the Sgt. At Arms. Members in attendance via the Zoom Video Conference connection may list their three suggestions in 'CHAT'. All suggestions will be tallied and counted by the Secretary/Treasurer and the Immediate Past President. The five members receiving the most 'mentions/recommendations' will be asked to serve on the committee and the member with the most mentions will be asked to chair the committee.
