Warren St. John is the author of the national bestsellers "Rammer Jammer Yellow Hammer: A Journey into the Heart of Fan Mania" (currently in development for television by Amazon Studios) and "Outcasts United: An American Town, a Refugee Team and One Woman's Quest to Make a Difference." For seven years he was a reporter for The New York Times, and before that, a writer for the New Yorker Magazine, the New York Observer

and Wired.

For the last nine years, St. John has been a member of the executive team of Patch, the hyperlocal news platform, serving at various points as Editor-in-Chief, CEO, President and now Chairman. Patch employs over 125 full-time local news reporters and is the largest platform in the U.S. dedicated to

original hyperlocal news coverage .

St. John attended The Altamont School in Birmingham, AL, and Columbia College in New York City. He lives in Manhattan with his wife and two children.
