This past week was one for the books and not in a good way. Lee and Charlotte County were hit very hard by Hurricane Ian, as we know. It is also important to know that Hardee and Highlands Counties, which are part of District 6890, were also among the hardest hit areas. Hardee County had the highest percentage of people without power in the State, and 77% of people in Highlands were also without power. There were reports that Wauchula was completely under water.

Our District Disaster Relief Chair, Kevin Kitto, with the help of District Rotarians, will be identifying needs with which we can assist. The District 6890 Foundation is prepared to match the first \$5,000 in donations received for Florida Hurricane Relief to help with these needs. 




