

#### \$400,000

Rotary Club of New Tampa has reached \$400,000 in all-time giving to the Rotary Foundation. Since its Charter Night on December 2, 1995 members of this club have consistently made donations to the Rotary Foundation to support its efforts to change lives both locally and around the world. In the past 28 years, the club has seen 13 members become Major Donors, 20 members have signed up as Benefactors, 5 members are Bequest Society members at both Level 1 and Level 3, 9 members are signed up as Paul Harris Society members, and 22 members are signed up for Rotary Direct. In total, 163 Paul Harris Fellows have been awarded including 57 (and counting) Multiple Paul Harris Fellows. The club became a 100% Paul Harris Fellow club in 2014-2015.

The contributions from the New Tampa club members has made a difference to lives all over the world including the effort to totally eradicate Polio. Grants in the form of District Designated Funds have also allowed the club to change lives in our local community.


