"Baseball can be a funny game" - Reflections on a career in the game



Larry Rothschild is a former professional baseball player, pitcher and coach who spent 11 years in the MLB playing for the Cincinnati Reds, Detroit Tigers, San Diego Padres and Chicago Cubs.

After his career in the majors ended, Rothschild worked as a coach with the Reds from 1986 to 1993, where he won a World Series as the team's bullpen coach in 1990. He then took stints at the Atlanta Braves and the Florida Marlins.

As the brand-new Tampa Bay Devil Rays sought their first manager, management couldn't stop talking about all the things Rothschild was - smart, hard-working, loyal and loaded with potential. From 1998 through 2001, he served as the Tampa Bay Devil Rays manager. After his time with the Rays, he went on to coach with the Chicago Cubs, New York Yankees, and the San Diego Padres.

Larry's career has resulted in many interesting and amusing stories, and we are excited to welcome him to Rotary!

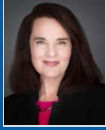
Service Above Self Day brought 30 volunteers to our community
