The U.S. Economy - What Can We Expect?



Eric Winograd is a Senior Vice President and Director of Developed Market Economic Research with Alliance Bernstein in New York City. He joins us via zoom on March 28 with deep insights into what we can expect from the US economy in the months ahead. In these volatile times, it should be a fascinating discussion. Local Bernstein representative **Stephanie Gibson** will be live at the meeting to facilitate our conversation as well.

Eric joined Berstein in 2017. From 2010 to 2016, he was the senior economist at MKP Capital Management, a US-based diversified alternatives manager. From 2008 to 2010, he was the senior macro strategist at HSBC North America. Earlier in his career, Winograd worked at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York and the World Bank. He holds a BA (cum laude) in Asian studies from Dartmouth College and an MA in international studies from the Paul H. Nitze School of Advanced International Studies.
