as President and CEO of Visit Tampa Bay, where he oversees daily operations, drives tourism growth, and serves as the primary spokesperson for the region's hospitality industry. Under his leadership, Visit Tampa Bay has earned national recognition, including multiple HSMAI Adrian Awards, and has celebrated three consecutive years of record-breaking bed tax collections.

Before joining Visit Tampa Bay, Corrada held key roles in city government, including Chief of Staff for the City of Tampa, where he oversaw more than 50 departments and helped host major events such as Super Bowl XLIII and the 2012 Republican National Convention. He also managed operations at the Tampa Convention Center and previously served as Director of Parks and Recreation for the City of Miami.

Corrada has been recognized with numerous honors, including HSMAI's Top 25 Extraordinary Minds in Hospitality Sales and Marketing and Hillsborough County's Hispanic Man of the Year. He sits on several boards, including the Florida Aquarium, Tampa Theatre, Straz Center, and US Travel Executive Board, among others.

He earned both his bachelor's and master's degrees in education from the University of Miami, graduating magna cum laude.
