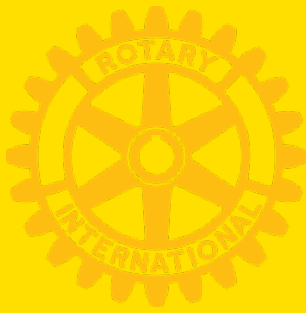


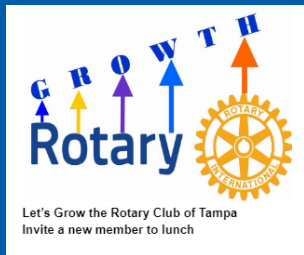

When the Righteous Triumph - A Story of Freedom



Tampa has so many stories to tell, Jim Davis and a team of influential Tampa leaders such as Arthenia Joyner, Sandy MacKinnon, Pan Iorio, Dick Greco, and many more, have teamed together to produce a play around one such story. Join us on February 11 for a preview and an inspiring look into our city's past.



When the Righteous Triumph is a powerful play about the 1960 sit-ins that led to the desegregation of lunch counters in downtown Tampa. It details the difficult race relations at the time and struggles for civil rights, and it acknowledges the compassion, immediate influence, and legacy of Rev. A. Leon Lowry and those involved. The play is a collaboration of Stageworks and Straz and will open March 6.

Jim Davis is a partner in the Public Policy & Regulatory group at Holland and Knight. Prior to joining Holland & Knight, Mr. Davis served in the U.S. House of Representatives for 10 years, representing the city of Tampa and portions of St. Petersburg, Bradenton and Hillsborough County, Florida. In 2006, Mr. Davis was the Democratic nominee for governor of Florida. Before entering Congress, Mr. Davis was a State Representative in the Florida House of Representatives from 1988 to 1996 and served as the House Majority Leader in 1995 and 1996.

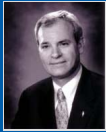
