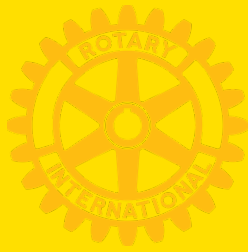

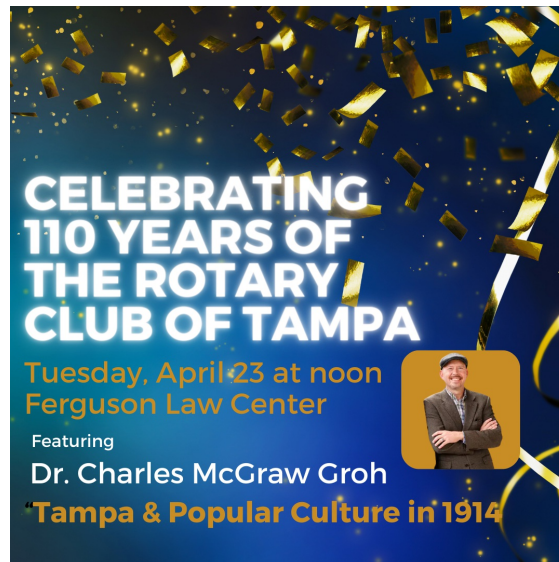
Offsite lunches and happy hour for Rotary gatherings this Tuesday
