The Angel that really made Rotary "International"

Local legend and retired judge E.J. Salcines tells a story like no other, and this week, he has a Rotary story to tell! When Rotary International chartered their first club in mainland Europe in Madrid, Spain in 1921, behind it all was Angel Cuesta, a cigar magnate and Tampa Rotarian originally from Spain.

While living in Tampa, Angel was assigned as special representative in 1920 and led an organizational meeting for the Madrid club in October 1920. The rest is history!
