September 19th meeting we had a presentation from Corporal Eric Smith of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR). Corporal Smith spoke to us about what the DNR is responsible for and shared updates on hunting and boating laws.

The Department of Natural Resources has statewide responsibilities for the management and conservation of Georgia's natural and cultural resources. Most of this work is conducted by DNR's five operating divisions, which have statutory authority over the management and protection of Georgia's natural and cultural resources. The Divisions also provide technical assistance, education and outreach and other programming relevant to their individual missions.

The Law Enforcement Division is responsible for protecting Georgia's wildlife, natural and cultural resources, DNR properties, enforcing boating, litter and waste laws, teaching hunter and boater education classes and providing public safety for the citizens of Georgia. Serving Georgia since 1911.
