Please join us tomorrow to hear from Chief Deputy Terron Hayes! Chief Deputy Terron K. Hayes is a native of Moultrie, Georgia he was born in 1975 to Randy Hayes and Pamela Zackery. Chief Hayes attended Colquitt County High School and later earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice and a Minor in Psychology from Albany State University.

While pursuing his college degree Chief Hayes served with the Albany Police Department as a Police Corporal. He also served as the President of the School Resource Officer Program and Regional Director for the Georgia Association of School Resource Officers. Chief Hayes also was a member of the Georgia Gang Investigator Association. While at APD Chief Hayes worked in the Uniform and Investigative Divisions.

Chief Hayes also worked for the Dougherty County School System Police Department where he served as a Police
