Dr. Dale is board certified in general surgery and focuses on surgical oncology (cancer).

He practices at Atrium Health Navicent and has an active surgical oncology clinical practice as co-director of the Peyton Anderson Cancer Center. He is the chief of surgical oncology and assistant dean of translational research at Mercer University School of Medicine.

Previously, he was the chief of surgical oncology and held the Margaret Proctor Mulligan Professorship in Breast Cancer Research at the University of Missouri School of Medicine. Dr. Dale was the director of the University of Missouri Biodesign and Innovation Program, one of only 4 such programs in the nation. He was also the director of the Ellis Fischel Cancer Center, the oldest cancer

center west of the Mississippi.


In addition to many presentations, publications and book chapters, Dr. Dale holds 2 US patents for the detection of cancer cells using photoacoustic technology. He received over \$3 Million in grant funding for research at the University of Missouri.

Dr. Dale received his master's degree in biomedical engineering and his medical degree at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. He completed residency at Mercer University, followed by a surgical oncology fellowship at the John Wayne Cancer Institute.

He and his wife are the parents of 2 children, both of whom followed their mother's career path into nursing. Outside of work, Dr. Dale enjoys playing golf, racing cars with his son and traveling on his motorcycle.
