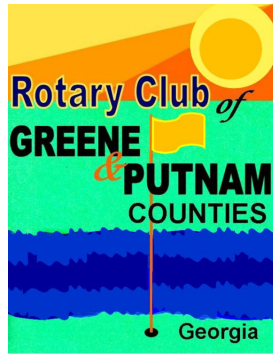


MISSION STATEMENT
