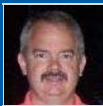

- **Asheville/Western North Carolina:** This area experienced significant storm damage and is in need of debris removal, home repairs, and general cleanup. We will focus our efforts on the YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly in Black Mountain, NC and 21 home rebuilds that need help in the Swannanoa, NC area.
