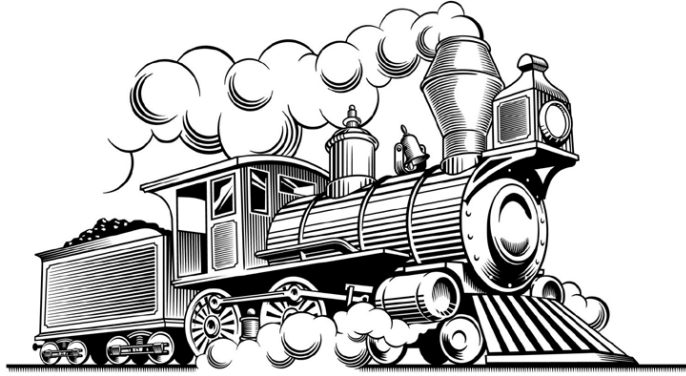


Gerry Tracker: ALL ABOARD!!!
