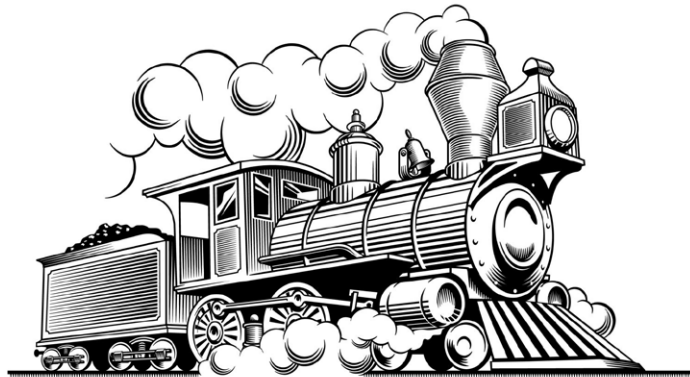
Kara holds a Ph.D. in Counseling & Student Affairs Administration from the University of Georgia and is a member of the International Coaching Federation.
