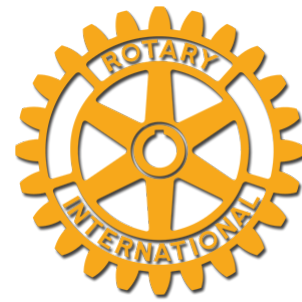

On August 8, 2022, our speaker will be Rotarian Joe Richardson from Lunch out of Landfills. As the owner of a summer camp, Joe Richardson has long been dedicated to environmental issues. The Bar-T Mountainside Challenge & Retreat Center and Summer Camp in Maryland runs on solar and geothermal energy; composting toilets save water. Richardson also runs after-school programs that include opportunities to learn about environmental issues. So, when a teacher at a local high school asked him to help start a program to stop food waste from ending up in landfills, Richardson, a member of the Rotary Club of Southern Frederick County (Urbana), Maryland, seized the

opportunity. He knew a lot about the logistics of garbage, having served on a special commission of Frederick County focused on the county's waste stream. He combined all his knowledge and developed a program at Urbana High School to keep "Lunch Out of Landfills" ([link](#)) that has rapidly expanded to other schools around the country. Joe Richardson will join as the speaker virtually.
