He also facilitates meetings and planning retreats for staff and elected bodies of local and state government. David has over 25 years of teaching experience with the Carl Vinson Institute of Government with the University of Georgia. He came to the Institute of Government in 1997 as an instructor in the State Government Training Program and was the primary teacher for the Child Support Enforcement program. Over the years, he has expanded his expertise into providing the broad range of training and facilitation services the Institute of Government offers. His teaching formats range from classroom teaching to personal coaching and facilitating group retreats.
