Lauren Gregory is a licensed master social worker who serves as the Grants & Community Coordinator at A Child's Voice Child Advocacy Center in Social Circle, GA. She received a Bachelor's of Science in Agriculture from the University of Georgia in 2012 and began her career in Walton County in 2012 working with the Walton County Family Connection and Youth Advocacy Board. She received a Master's in Social Work from the University of Georgia in 2016 and began working at A Child's Voice, providing direct services to children and families who have experienced child sexual abuse and other forms of maltreatment. In this role, Lauren provided resources, education and support to families during times of crises surrounding disclosures of abuse, working to ensure children were able to heal from the trauma they experienced. In her current role, Lauren manages the agency's grant funding, including writing and managing grants from a local to a federal level. She also provides training and support for adults in the community to create safe environments for children, and to equip adults to react appropriately to situations of abuse. She is passionate about bringing

together all facets of the community to ensure children are protected and adults are proactive in keeping children safe and healthy. Lauren lives in downtown Monroe with her family.

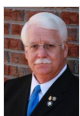

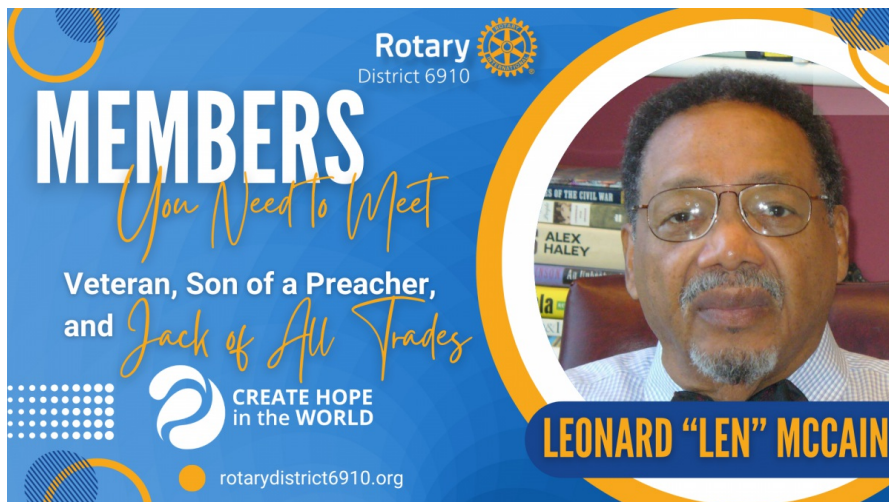

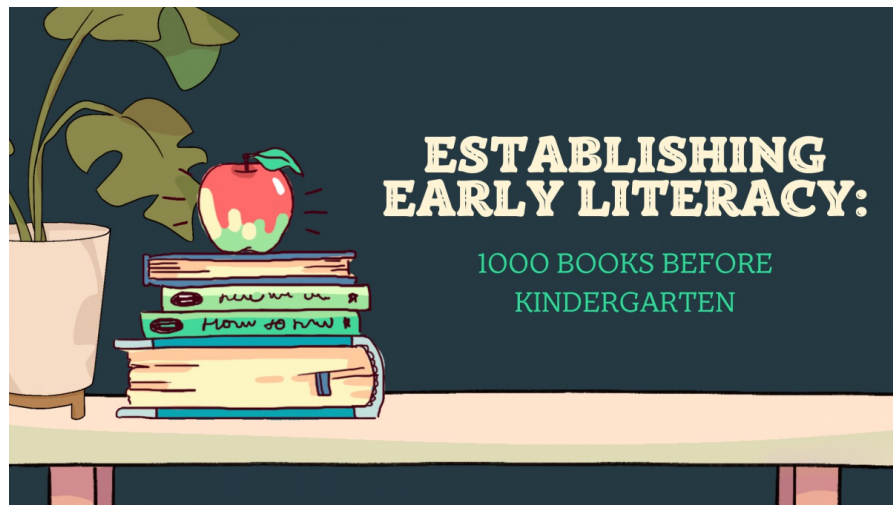

Establishing Early Literacy Skills at the Library: 1000 Books Before Kindergarten

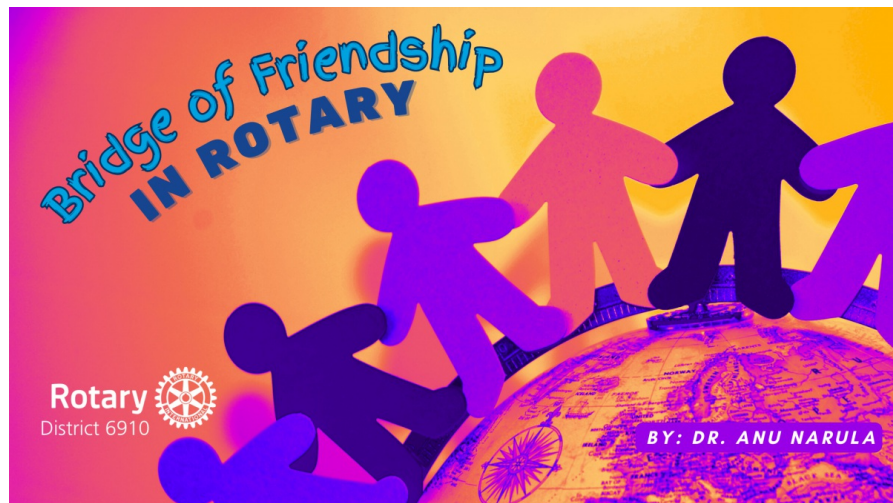

It all began with the power of friendship. Some one hundred and nineteen years ago, four men called Paul Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram E. Shorey from downtown Chicago in Illinois started Rotary in 1905. This small fellowship of friends formed with the view of celebrating friendship and professional bonding went through phenomenal changes over time and evolved into one of the largest humanitarian organizations in the world with 1.4 million members as of now. We all know that over the decades, the seven areas of focus and a number of ideals, themes, and mottos have been embraced by Rotary, but one thing that has remained constant is the value of friendships, fellowships, and vocational/personal connections in Rotary. “Friendship was the foundation rock on which Rotary was built and tolerance is the element which holds it together,” affirmed Paul Harris in 1948.
