
Club Member Anniversaries





Establishing Early Literacy Skills at the Library: 1000 Books Before Kindergarten



It all began with the power of friendship. Some one hundred and nineteen years ago, four men called Paul Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram E. Shorey from downtown Chicago in Illinois started Rotary in 1905. This small fellowship of friends formed with the view of celebrating friendship and professional bonding went through phenomenal changes over time and evolved into one of the largest humanitarian organizations in the world with 1.4 million members as of now. We all know that over the decades, the seven areas of focus and a number of ideals, themes, and mottos have been embraced by Rotary, but one thing that has remained constant is the value of friendships, fellowships, and vocational/personal connections in Rotary. "Friendship was the foundation rock on which Rotary was built and tolerance is the element which holds it together,†affirmed Paul Harris in 1948.


