Nipuna Ambanpola – Biography

Nipuna was selected to the Georgia Rotary Student Program in 2015 from Sri Lanka sponsored by the Rotary Clubs of Savannah South and Savannah West. Nipuna is the Founder & Executive Director of IVolunteer International, a 501(c)3 tech-nonprofit and is employed fulltime as the Research & Public Service Manager at the J.W. Fanning Institute for Leadership Development at the University of Georgia.

Nipuna has been involved in the Rotary family since 2009, first through Interact, and now in Rotaract and Rotary. He has served Rotary in multiple positions, starting as the Interact President of his high school, the District Interact Secretary for District 3220, Founding President of the Rotaract Club of Georgia Southern, Founding District Rotaract Representative for the Rotary District 6920, a Board Member of the NoBorders Rotaract e-Club and a member of the

Rotary District 6920, a Board Member of the NoBorders Rotaract e-Club and a member of the University of Georgia Rotaract Club. Nipuna is a Paul Harris Fellow and a Will Watt Fellow. Nipuna was also selected as a Rotary Youth-All Star by Rotary International in 2017. Nipuna now serves as the Assistant Governor for Rotarct for the District 6910.

An avid volunteer himself, Nipuna has spoken about the power of community volunteering in a variety of forums including the World Forum for Democracy in Europe, University Leadership Symposium in Malaysia, and the Global Goals Summit at the United Nations. In 2017, Nipuna spoke at TEDx Savannah on how volunteering can unite the world. Nipuna also serves as a Program Advisor to Humanitarian Affairs Asia, a Young Leader at the United Way of the Coastal Empire, a Steering Committee Member of the International Research & Exchange Board and a Civil Society Youth Representative at the United Nations Department for Global Communications.

Nipuna earned his undergraduate degree in Economics at Georgia Southern University and Masters in Public Administration & Policy and a Masters in Business Analytics at the University of Georgia. Nipuna is also an IBM Artificial Intelligence Design Thinking Practitioner.
