Anna Stenport is Dean of the Franklin College of Arts and Sciences, UGA Foundation Professor in Arts and Sciences, and Professor of Communication Studies, with an appointment in the Louise McBee Institute of Higher Education at the University of Georgia. Dr. Stenport is a scholar of comparative media and cultural studies with a focus on the Arctic and Nordic regions, having published eleven books and nearly seventy articles and chapters.

Bringing extensive experience in higher education leadership, Dr. Stenport held appointments at Rochester Institute of Technology, Georgia Institute of Technology, the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, Stanford University, the University of California, Berkeley, and a number of international institutions before joining UGA, one of her alma maters. She is committed to advancing the public good through partnerships within and beyond universities that advance community, collaboration, creativity, and inclusive excellence.

Dr. Stenport earned her doctorate from the University of California, Berkeley, and holds her bachelorâ€[™]s and masterâ€[™]s degrees from Uppsala University, Sweden.
