Sheri C. Hardee is the Dean and a Professor in the College of Education at the University of North Georgia, where she began working in 2009. She has a Ph.D. in Social Foundations in Education and an M.A. in English from the University of South Carolina, Columbia.

In her research, she examines equity, equality, and inclusion in regard to access to and support in institutions of higher education, starting with support provided within middle- and high-school environments. In particular, she has examined both mentoring and college-ready support programs. She has taught both undergraduate and graduate courses in the Social Foundations of Education and has published multiple book chapters and articles in journals such as *Teaching Education*, *The Journal of Educational Foundations*, *Thresholds in Education*, and the International Council of Professors of

She first began teaching college English in 2003 and has been in education in different capacities for 18 years, working mostly with middle-, high-school-, and college-aged students. Additionally, she started college as a TRIO student and worked with federal TRIO programs for nine years. The TRIO programs ♦are Federal outreach and student services programs designed to identify and provide services for individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds ♦ (U.S. Department of Education).

As a first-generation, low-income college student, she credits TRIO programs with helping her to successfully navigate college and leading her down a path of assisting students from similar backgrounds. One of her goals for the College of Education at the University of North Georgia is to provide opportunities and support for underrepresented students and to encourage future educators to create classrooms environments where they provide these same supports for their students. Although she says she got into teaching ♦by accident, ♦ it was definitely the best accident that could have ever happened, as she cannot imagine a more rewarding career.

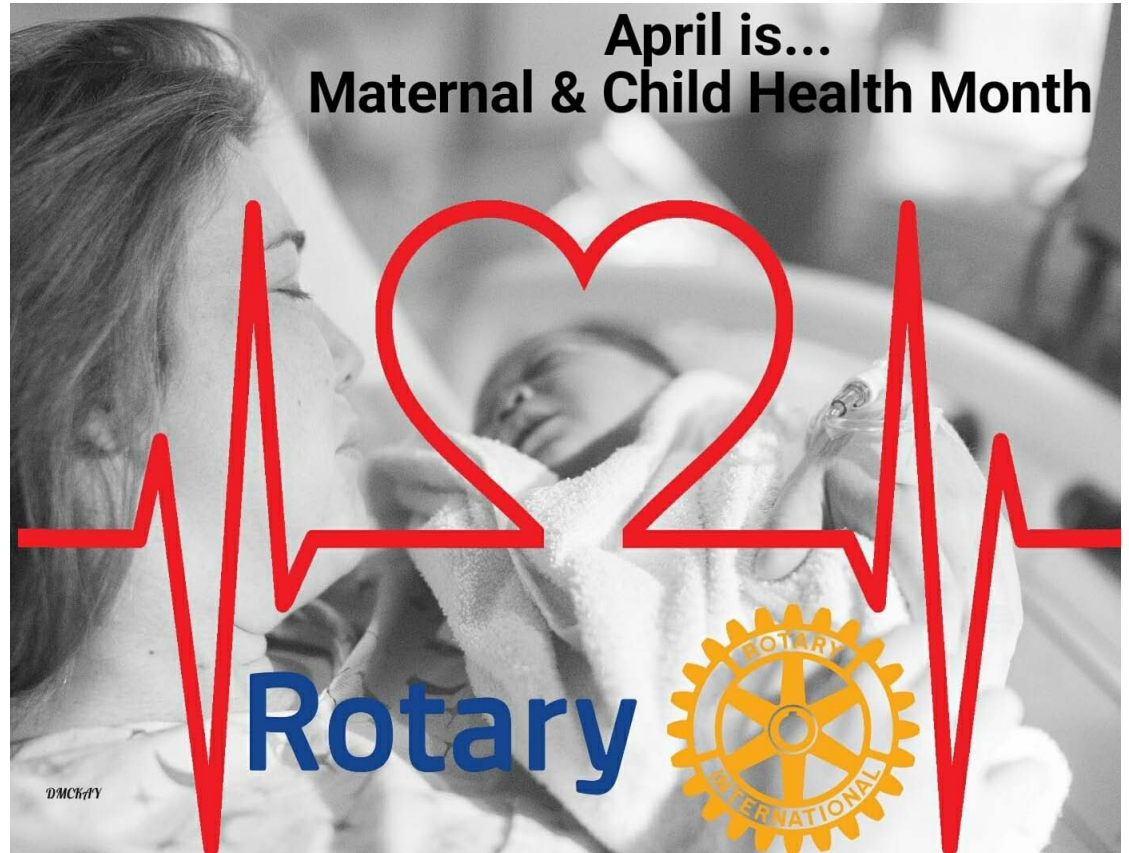
RYLA Scheduled for June 3rd-6th

April is Child and Maternal Health Month

April is... Maternal & Child Health Month



April is Child and Maternal Health Month when Rotarians all over the world focus on this important Rotary Foundation Area of Focus.

Through grants from The Rotary Foundation, Rotarians improve access to essential medical services for mothers and their children. These efforts are aimed at reducing the number of children under age five who die each year because of malnutrition, inadequate health care, and poor sanitation ♦ a figure that is currently estimated at 7 million.

According to another estimate, more than 80 percent of maternal deaths can be prevented with access to reproductive health services and trained health care workers. Rotarians provide education, immunizations, birthing kits, and mobile health clinics to support these causes. Women are taught how to prevent mother-to-infant HIV transmission, how to breast-feed, and how to protect themselves and their children from disease.
