Sam Pardue, Dean of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, UGA



Dr. Pardue is a native of Yadkin County, North Carolina. He received his B.S. degree in Poultry Science from NC State University in 1977. He earned his M.S. and Ph.D. in Physiology, also from NC State, in 1979 and 1983, respectively. Between his graduate degrees, he served as a Biology Instructor in the Lenoir Community College Nursing Program. Following his Ph.D., he was the recipient of a post-doctoral fellowship sponsored by the National Institutes of Health at the University of Massachusetts-Amherst in the Veterinary & Animal Sciences Department.

In 1986, he was appointed to the rank of assistant professor at Texas A&M University. Approximately four years later, he returned to NC State to join the faculty of the Department of Poultry Science as its Undergraduate Teaching Coordinator. He spent a six-month Study Leave (sabbatical) in the Animal and Veterinary Bioscience unit at the University of Sydney, New South Wales, Australia. He was later named an Alumni Distinguished Undergraduate Professor in 2000 and in 2005 he was named Head of Poultry Science.

Dr. Pardue is a member of the Academy of Outstanding Teachers and has also been recognized nationally as the recipient of the Purina Mills Award for Outstanding Teaching and the Poultry Science Association Student Recruitment Award. He is the co-inventor of three patents and has received more than \$2.5 million in grants and contracts during his career. In 2006, NC State Chancellor James Oblinger appointed him to Chair the Faculty Academic Committee of the University's Council on Athletics. Beginning in July 2009, he assumed the role of Faculty Athletic Representative for the University to the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC). He would later serve as the Vice President and President of the ACC.

He is a Food Systems Leadership Institute Fellow, (Cohort 3, 2007-09) and an ESCOP/ACOP Leadership Development Program graduate, (Class 5, 1996). In July, 2012, he was appointed as the interim Associate Dean & Director of Academic Programs for the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences (CALS) at NC State and later Associate Dean in May of 2013. While in this role, he has facilitated donations in excess of \$13 million for the College's Academic Programs.

In March of 2016, he was appointed Dean and Director of the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences at the University of Georgia. Dr. Pardue and his wife Stacy are the proud parents of two children, Caitlin and Taylor, and reside in Watkinsville, in Oconee County, Georgia.

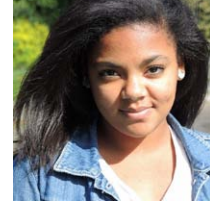
