Upcoming Rotary Program: David Bruce Weiner, Consul and Senior Trade Commissioner, Consulate General of Canada



David Weiner is Consul and Senior Trade Commissioner at the Consulate General of Canada in Atlanta, GA. Mr. Weiner is a career diplomat, having served with the Canadian Foreign Service since 1991. This is Mr. Weiner's fifth assignment in the United States. He came to Atlanta from Canada's Consulate General in Dallas, where he won the Professional Association of Foreign Service Officers Award for his success in strengthening the performance of his team, which ranked third globally for business successes and received a 100% client satisfaction ranking. While in Dallas, Weiner also brought several large new investments to Canada including a \$450 million expansion by Bell Helicopter of Fort Worth. Prior to Dallas, Mr. Weiner served in Detroit where he worked on the Government of Canada's rescue package for GM and Chrysler, made significant contributions to the regrowth of Canada's U.S. automotive trade following the recession, and generated strong investment attraction results including a \$716 million expansion of Ford's Oakville, ON plant.

Mr. Weiner also served on assignments to the Canadian Embassies in Washington, DC; Brasilia, and Berlin and opened a Canadian Consulate in Philadelphia. He has an extensive background in international business development and trade policy. Before joining the Canadian Foreign Service, Mr. Weiner spent several years in the private sector where he held international marketing positions in the pharmaceutical industry.

Mr. Weiner graduated McGill University with a BA in international affairs and international business (1983). He is married to Marilda Weiner, originally from Brazil, and has two children.
