Winford ◆Buck◆ Lindsay heads an architectural/engineering/interiors firm, Lindsay Pope Brayfield Clifford, in Lawrenceville, Georgia, since 1975. After graduating from Georgia Tech in 1968, he enlisted in the US Army, and was discharged three years later at the rank of captain. He then spent a year in south France as a free-lance artist. Lindsay◆s architectural specialization is hospitality; he has designed hundreds of hotels throughout the USA and Canada.

In 1995, he was named Volunteer-of-the-Year in Gwinnett by United Way, and in 2000 was Gwinnett County Small Businessman-of-the-Year. In 2004, he was elected a Fellow of the American Institute of Architects. He served as Rotary club president in 1981, and as District 6910 Governor in 1991. In 1996, he founded Rotarian Action Group for Population & Development, a 20,000+ member group of Rotarians who believe that humanity is on a collision course: too many people / too few resources ◆ and that Rotary can do something about it.




He has worked on international humanitarian projects in every corner of the world. He served on the board of The Population Institute for 20 years. Buck enjoys fitness programs, architectural sketching and ballroom dancing. He is 2018 and current top-ranked male amateur dancer, according to US Dance Championship Circuit. Buck and his wife Cindy live in Duluth, and have two adult sons.

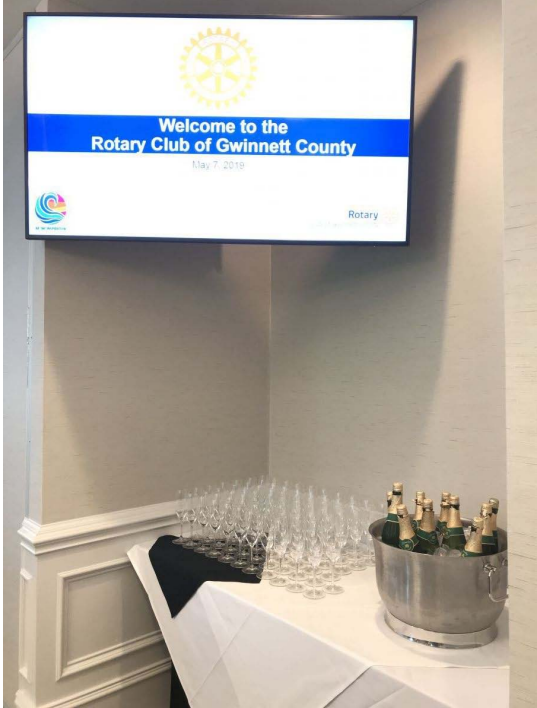
