

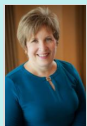

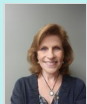

This is what Iâ€™ve learned from these services: families and friends are rarely prepared for a loved oneâ€™s death, even when itâ€™s long and drawn out. Death stings us and the void left behind can seem insurmountable. I believe it true that grief is the price we pay for loving. So the moral to my story is this: Realize time is both precious and fleeting and, you never know when the last time will be the last time. Love on those special to you. Hug often. Never take time with loved ones for granted. I hope this helps someone."

We welcomed our third new member into our club this Rotary year at our Monday, July 22, 2024, meeting.

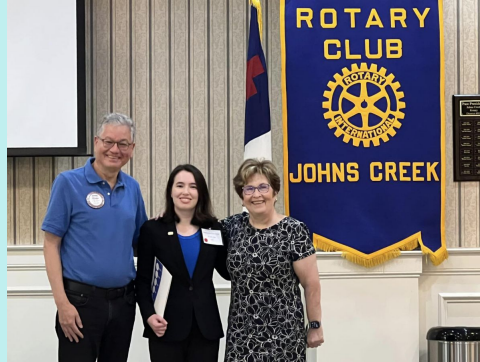
