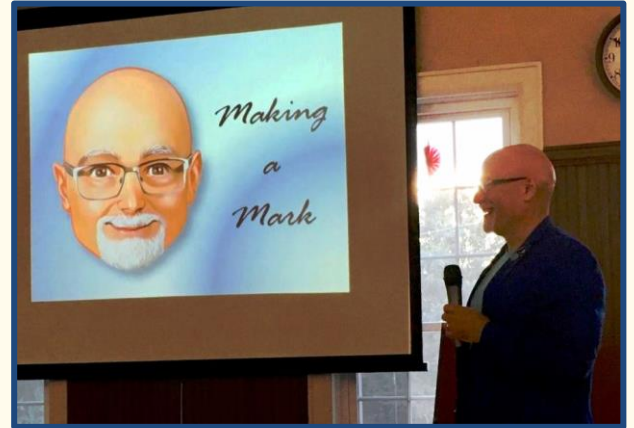
OUR MOST RECENT MEETING
