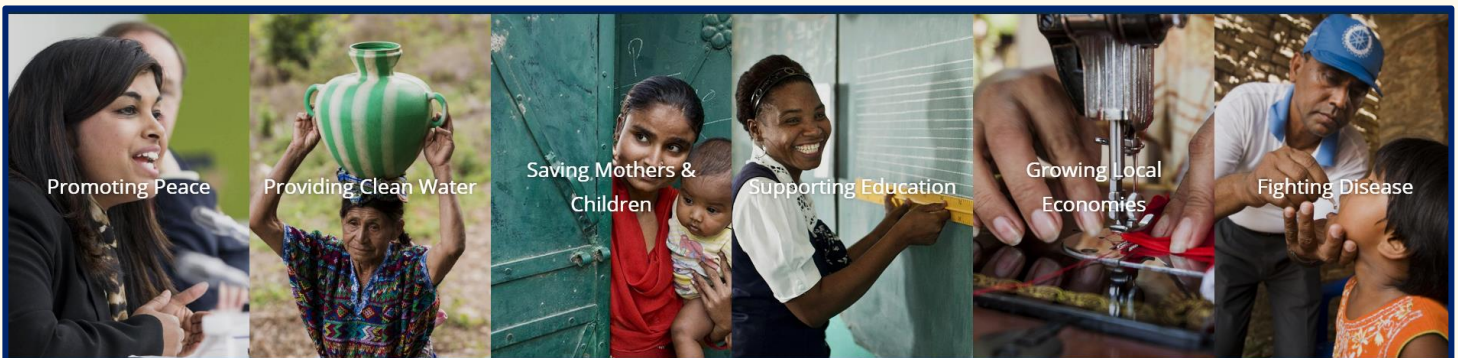


The Future of Rotary is Here!

OUR MOST RECENT MEETING



The Rotary Foundation began 101 years ago at the Rotary Convention in Atlanta with a contribution of \$26.50. Since then, our foundation has spent over \$3 billion making the world a better place. Today the Rotary Foundation focuses on the six causes you see above. The main focus is still the eradication of polio. We're down to 20 cases in just two countries – we really are this close. President Mark's presentation mentioned that every member of the club is a sustaining member through a \$100 annual contribution. The club is recognized for having 100% participation and per member giving of at least \$100. Fifty percent of the funds given by our district come back to the district in three years for district grants. Your contributions support projects in Buford and Burundi, Suwanee and Sudan.
