21 Day Racial Equity Challenge

As Rotarians, while becoming more and more aware of the disparities that many people in our communities face, we are committed to work as community leaders to help address those needs. Starting in March, Rotary Districts 6900, 6910, and 6920 will work in partnership with United Way of Greater Atlanta to promote a powerful 21-Day Racial Equity Challenge, giving all Georgia Rotarians the unique opportunity to take a deeper dive into the discussion of racial equity and healing. The challenge will be a free, self-guided learning experience where participants will receive three emails per week for seven weeks (hence 21 total days) with readings, videos, podcasts, and ways to take action. The learning will explore the history and impact of racism in our communities and how it s shaped community development work across the Atlanta region and beyond. This is a great opportunity to learn more,

grow as an ally, and advocate and
