PROGRAM



Dubose Porter,

Executive Director of the Georgia Trust for Local News

DuBose Porter grew up in Dublin and graduated from Davidson College in 1975 with a BA in English. Porter then received his JD from Cumberland Law School at Samford University and returned home to practice law in 1979.

Porter was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives in 1982. During his tenure in the Georgia House of Representatives, Porter chaired the Education and the Higher Education committees and then served as Speaker Pro Tempore. Porter served on the Appropriations, Natural Resources and Judiciary committees. Porter also served as the Administration Floor Leader for Governor Zell Miller and introduced and passed the Hope Scholarship legislation on Miller's behalf, which funded the pre-k program, technology and the HOPE Grant for the technical school system and the HOPE Scholarship for Georgia's University System. Porter also spear-headed the effort for Preservation 2000 that set aside over 100,000 of Georgia's most environmentally challenged lands, along with sponsoring the River Corridor Protection Act. As Speaker Pro Tempore, Porter was the architect for the legislation that formed the Georgia Public Defender System.

Locally, Porter championed the effort to place a campus of the University System, which is now the Dublin Campus of Middle Georgia State University and the expansion of the Technical School System with the development of the Heart of Georgia Technical College, now named the Oconee Fall Line Technical College. Porter also worked to obtain funding for the 441 Bypass, the Downtown Dublin Bypass, the redevelopment of the Downtown Dublin Corridor. Porter also worked to provide two wildlife management areas, with Riverbend and Beaver Dam, along the Hugh Gillis Public Fishing Area.

PROGRAM CONTINUED

Porter is the Executive Director of the Georgia Trust for Local News. A longtime newspaperman based in Dublin, Ga., Porter is the former president of the Georgia Press Association and has a deep knowledge of the strengths and challenges facing newspapers across rural areas of the state. He brings a lifelong career in publishing and public service to the role, including as publisher of the Dublin Courier-Herald Group. Porter was a charter board member and continues to serve on the board of the Georgia First Amendment Foundation.
