Matt is a native of Dublin, Georgia. He is an Eagle Scout from Troop 68 and was an honor graduate of Dublin High School. He graduated from Presbyterian College with a BS Degree in Applied Mathematics with an Economic Emphasis.

Matt was elected to House District 150 in November 2010. He serves as Chairman of the House Appropriations committee and as a member of the Economic Development & Tourism committee; Energy, Utilities and Telecommunications committee; Health & Human Services committee and the Rules committee. Matt served as one of Governor Deal's Floor Leaders from June 2011 until September 2013 when he was elected by his peers to serve as the chairman of the House Majority Caucus. Hatchett served as majority caucus chairman until July of 2021 when he again was elected by the majority caucus to serve as Majority Whip until he was appointed as the Chairman of the House Appropriations committee in December of 2022.

After redistricting in 2021, Matt began serving in District 155, which now includes all of Laurens and Johnson counties.

Matt and his family are members of the Dublin First Methodist Church. He and his wife, Kim have two beautiful daughters, Emily and Camille.
