**Sign Up for United Reads!**

Reading proficiency by 3rd grade is the most important indicator of high school graduation and career success. It is estimated that 2/3 of Georgia’s 3rd graders are not reading at grade level and children who can’t read proficiently by 3rd grade are 4 times more likely to drop out of high school. United Way of Central Georgia prepares the curriculum, provides all the necessary materials, and has on site coordinators at the schools to oversee the program. All we have to do as a club is come up with volunteers who are willing to give up 1 hour of their time each week to tutor these students at Morningside Elementary. Last year, we began the program at Morningside Elementary in the second semester of the year and by year-end 84% of the children we tutored were reading at grade level. THE PROGRAM WORKS!!!

This year we will be reading at Morningside Elementary on Mondays and Wednesdays from 8:30 - 9:30. Pick one day, or both. The Read United training for new volunteers will be on Thursday August 24 from 10:00 am - 12:00 pm. The training for returning volunteers will be on the same day from 1:00pm - 2:30pm. Location TBA.
