This Week's Program - Dr. John D. Northup



John D. Northup, M.D., has enjoyed a career in private practice specializing in internal medicine, gastroenterology and addiction medicine. The media have interviewed him on numerous occasions for his involvement in environmental and inner-city causes. He is a graduate of Amherst College, The Yale University School of Medicine, The New York Hospital - Cornell Medical Center, the National Institutes of Health, Duke University, and the Mayo Clinic. He holds the military rank of Lieutenant Commander.

Today, he will talk with our Club about Fentanyl. Chatham County is losing one child per week to death from Fentanyl and last year 100,000 Americans died from Fentanyl. This is the leading cause of death for Americans between ages 18-48. He will discuss who takes it, and the legal and medical efforts to deal with the Fentanyl crisis.
