
Safe and Clean Streets, Safe and Clean Water!

Mayor Eula Clarke of Stuart was our speaker today and she brought us up to speed on all the new construction planned and underway in Stuart.

She pointed out that more than 1500 housing units are being developed within the city's boundaries. Much of the construction will

be townhouses and apartments to fill the need for more affordable housing in our growing area.



She was asked about the plans for the new Costco Store that has been mentioned on S. Kanner highway. She pointed out that the developers have been meeting with city officials and that it would be on the agenda for Thursday Evenings Local Planning Agency. (Ed. Note: It was approved unanimously Thursday Night. It will be discussed May 24th at the City Council Meeting.) The site south of the Martin County high school will also include 300 apartments and restaurant spaces. More than 150 jobs will be created at the Costco.



Mayor Clarke mentioned an important new program that is just kicking off in the East Stuart neighborhood called CARP ♦ Cops Are Real People. The plan is to humanize police officials and to build relationships with the young residents of Stuart. The Gertrude Walden Center is directing the program. More
