support services to children ages 2 to 18 with autism and other related disabilities . Founded in 2018, the group has facilities in Palm City and Port St. Lucie. They work with the whole child in developing motor skills, language development, and also deal with physical challenges and socialization issues.

Medicaid and other government programs are available but quite complex, resulting in the group having to fight insurance companies to adequately fund recommended treatments. The team also develops data to track behaviors and progress for each child to support the diagnoses by neuro-psychologists.
