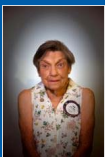

Gina Masters, Stuart-Martin Chamber of Commerce, Career Connect

Gina Masters is the Program Coordinator for Career Connect Martin. This is a Federal grant program created by the Stuart-Martin County Chamber to help hire, train and retain quality entry level employees for jobs in Martin County. The program is in its second year and has helped train and place 46 employees with 26 different firms. Gina said that they provide candidate screening and soft skill training including resume creation, interviewing skills, and career preference testing.

The program teams with local employers. Career Connect provides paid salary and insurance during training (120 hours) and

\$15 an hour salary to start. They also work with candidates with background issues. They also direct candidates to other resources within the county. She told of a retired teacher who decided to go back to work, came to Career Connect and has been placed in a school as a teacher.
