VIM - Providing a Major Community Service

Our speakers today were VIM staffers Mia Cruz and Mary Fields.

Volunteers in Medicine provides free medical care to Martin County residents between the ages of 18 and 64 who have no medical insurance. Founded in 1993, the group is staffed by retired doctors and nurses. The team provides primary health care including annual checkups, health screenings, chronic disease treatment and assistance with obtaining medications. They partner with local specialists who volunteer to treat a variety of issues at no cost to you. They have a wellness program to help you stay that way.



Last year VIM served more than 1,000 patients and the 12 doctors and staff provided lab work, biopsies and guidance to people dealing with cancer and other diseases. The VIM was recognized nationally with the Points of Light award from President Bush.

Rotarian Dr. Bill Tozzo was a key member of VIM and served as President of the organization early in its life. Through his efforts, Stuart-Sunrise Rotary was involved in providing equipment and volunteers. The organization today has a budget of \$1 million. They are funded through grants, memorial gifts and a strong volunteer staff. They host a Gala each February that raises funds and a golf tournament in cooperation with Carsons Tavern and its charity efforts.

There are now 89 similar volunteer medical service organizations in the US.
