Kiss the Ground Documentary Facilitated by Marcy Ullom By Ailish Nic Phaidin

THE MAGIC

OF ROTARY

This was truly one of the most interesting, enlightening and uplifting meetings we have had. All members were requested to watch the documentary: "Kiss the Ground" so that we could have an in-depth discussion on the video and issues surrounding climate change and the ramifications for us all. The film's website has annotated 38 awards, including the prestigious Tribeca Film Festival 2020 Award. The film is on Netflix and if you have not seen it, I would be happy to have you at my home to watch it. You'll come away with an entirely different person. Out discussion was led by Marcy Ullom, past DG

and member of an e-club in District 6990.

The movie was narrated by Woody Harrelson. From its website: "Kiss the Ground is an inspiring and groundbreaking film that reveals the first viable solution to our climate crisis. Kiss the Ground reveals that, by regenerating the world's soils, we can completely and rapidly stabilize Earth's climate, restore lost ecosystems and create abundant food supplies. Using compelling graphics and visuals, along with striking NASA and NOAA footage, the film artfully illustrates how, by drawing down atmospheric carbon, soil is the missing piece of the climate puzzle.

This movie is positioned to catalyze a movement to accomplish the impossible – to solve humanity's greatest challenge, to balance the climate and secure our species future." The discussion began with agriculture and the reasons for allowing agriculture to use poisonous chemical pesticides to enhance growth, kill weeds. Linda Seals enlightened us all on much to do with soil, e.g. there are over 2bn organisms in 2 cubic feet of soil. The fact that there are so many mega corporate farms that require tillage, which destroys the soil, all in an effort to make more and easier money. Corporate farming does not care if they deplete the soil. When it's destroyed, they simply move somewhere else to "follow the money". One farmer on the documentary was inspirational in that he changed his method of farming having moved from tillage to livestock and was able to also continue to till his land with specialized equipment so not to destroy the land and thus also plant other alternative crops, thus spreading his ability to earn more income from his farm. Much of the land has been lost to urbanization and development. Soil has more of an impact on our climate than fossil fuel in that the soil stores lots and lots of carbon. Government underwriting farming is also a problem, e.g. growing sugar cane in Florida which was begun to thwart Cuba 60-70 years ago and is still being subsidized by the federal government. It is estimated that in twenty-five years that two-thirds of the world will be desert. That's a frightening piece of data.




