GUEST SPEAKER

The guest speaker last week was Akili Phillips, Development Coordinator for FAMILY PROMISE OF BREVARD (FP), a program based in Cocoa FL. FP is often confused with Promise of Brevard in Melbourne that helps challenged young adults live in a community environment. FP provides housing and hope with a program of prevention, shelter, and stabilization. The group targets housing insecurity with an offer of “having a safe, secure, and affordable place to call home.”

Phillips outlined a project called FP- the Firehouse Project for Cocoa. Fund raising events are scheduled to provide an administrative, partner, housing, and meeting facility. Success stories were shared. More details can be found at FamilyPromiseofBrevard.org.
