### **BOARD OK'S FUNDRAISING**

LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL PROJECTS TO GO FORWARD



#### **DELRAY ROTARY EXTENDS ITS REACH**

Sister Cities of Delray Beach and the Rotary Club of Delray Beach are joining together with the Rotary Club of Moshi, Tanzania to support the Kariwa Primary School in Moshi by building a septic system and a block of 8 toilets for the students.

The school has 245 students, from ages 5-13. Currently, they have 8 outhouse-style toilets, two of which are not functional. Our project adds 8 flush toilets as well as handwash stations outside of the building. The cost of the bathroom block is roughly TZ Shillings 16,325,000, or just over 7,000 USD. Sister Cities of Delray Beach has provided \$3,000, the Kariwa school (parents and friends) are providing \$1,000, and the Rotary Club of Delray Beach will provide \$3,000. The Rotary Club of Moshi will provide project oversight, and will make up any overages above the \$7,000.

By committing \$3000, the Board is asking members to make some contribution to "Delray Beach Rotary Club, Inc." our 501 (c) (3) specifically for this project. At the time of the meeting, over \$1500 has already been pledged by currently serving Board members.

# ANNE BRIGHT ISSUES MATCHING FUNDS CHALLENGE









At the Board meeting on July 12th, Fundraising Committee Chair, Anne Bright issued a direct fundraising challenge to Delray Beach Rotarians. Anne has pledged up to \$1000 in matching funds to support traditional Delray Rotary projects, such as the Miracle League, Little League, our annual Adopt-A-Family project at the Achievement Center for Children & Families, Student & Teacher of the Month, and others. The pledge is conditional on the club being willing to also commit up to \$1000 in matching funds, while asking for individual contributions from the members, with the goal of raising \$4000 for the club's immediate needs in the 2022-23 Rotary Year. Anne's motion for the Board to certify the fundraising plan was seconded and passed, and the proposed deadline for member contributions is September 30th. Speaking on behalf of Anne's challenge, The Wheel is asking for help from all Rotarians, so we will be able to continue to support these worthwhile community sustaining organizations.
