Monroe St., Tallahassee, FL 32311 in Killen Hall. The room is located at the corner of E. Call St. and N. Calhoun St. It is handicap accessible. Free parking is available in the St. John's lot in front of and behind the closed bookstore across the street or in the large Capital City Bank lot next to E. Tennessee St. and N. Calhoun St.

Our presenter will be David Proctor, History Professor at TCC and member of the St. John's Historical Society. He'll be taking us on a tour and talking about the history of St. John's as it relates to the community of Tallahassee. St. John's began holding services in 1827 so it is almost 200 years old with a rich history in the community. I've requested a bio to use to introduce him.
