

Beyond environmental restoration, the Rotary Club leads and supports a range of impactful programs, such as Adopt a Precinct, Backpacks of Hope, and the Cotee River Flats Classic fishing tournament. The club also partners with organizations like the YMCA and RAP House, offers college scholarships, and supports the PHSC Foundation. Each of these initiatives reflects the club's ongoing dedication to improving the lives of children, families, and the entire Pasco County and region, in alignment with Rotary International's vision of service above self.
