# Last Week


Our speaker last week was our very own Mike Beam. Mike has been in our Club for 15 years, is a Past President, a Paul Harris Fellow Plus 2 and the Chair for the Disaster Relief Program. Mike spoke about Hurricane Ian and how it missed us. He said, "It's all about timing." With 30,000 new residents that have never dealt with a hurricane before, they have a lot to learn. Our shelves in the grocery stores were out of food and necessities long before the hurricane changed directions. He said that Fort Myers has a long recovery period ahead of them. We were collecting supplies to bring down there this past Sunday. Mike showed us photos of before and after pictures of the areas hit the hardest. When you live in a mobile home and they say evacuate - do it! The photos and short clips showed roofs being torn off and walls just coming down. Mike said, "Treat this as a dress rehearsal." Along with the other things that you should have in your emergency box is a phone bank charger. Preferably a solar powered one to keep your phone charged. Also keep a battery powered radio. so you will know when it is safe to go outside again. For packing things to send to Fort Myers, most

needed are tarps and heavy duty Visqueen, roofing nails and tar paper. Mostly needed items include baby formula, diapers and feminine hygiene products. All money collected will go to District 6960 and will be used to do repairs to Rotarian's and First Responder's homes.

We would like to thank Mike for an interesting and informative program. We will be donating a book to the Richey Elementary School Library in his name.






