

He's home. Bruce texted, "I achieved my coast to coast pedaling goal from Rehoboth Beach, Delaware to the Santa Monica Pier November 27. The awesome adventure of a lifetime covered 3,830 miles through 14 states plus DC over 111 days.

"I deeply appreciate all the moral support from friends and relatives and especially those who joined me on the route. After my last post from Kingman, Arizona, cousin Ed Leach stayed with me through the quirky town of Oatman, Arizona, where live burros own the streets and then to the casino town of Laughlin, Nevada and into California. Brother-in-law Matt Sagues and my son Brian Mills joined up for 3 days of unexpectedly cold primitive camping in the Mohave Desert. Matt should be a professional outfitter as he set up all the first class camping gear and cooked gourmet meals. The Mohave Desert took 3.5 days to cycle and included a 2,200' climb to it's peak so the SAG crew was a great help.

"Solo again, later sites included Elmer's Bottle Tree Farm, Emma Jean's Cafe (from the Kill Bill movie), rough dirt trails near El Cajon, and the Santa Anita racetrack. I had been wary of the three day pedal through Metropolitan Los Angeles, but it turned out surprisingly well except when I detoured from the vetted bike path to sightsee on Hollywood Boulevard and Rodeo Drive. I reached Santa Monica on the penultimate evening but stopped within 2 miles from the Pier to stay at Brian's apartment. Yesterday Brian and I stopped by the RAND Corp Think Tank where he is a graduate student and researcher and cycled along 'The Strand' beach bike trail to Venice Beach and back.

"It was wonderful to have Sister-in-law



Amy Vogel Sagues drive down from the Bay Area (that other Bay Area) to meet us at the finish line with an American Flag and homemade signs. Nadia Leach joined us for a celebratory dinner and I woke up this morning and didn't have a reason to pedal. I never once had second thoughts on the journey, but in the words of Forrest Gump, 'I think I'll go home now.'"

Welcome home! Congratulations Bruce, on a job well done. I hope you raised a lot of money for the Lighthouse for the Blind!




